Introduces the philosophy of educational athletics and then focuses on roles of the NIAAA, the NFHS, the State Athletic/Activity Associations and the State Athletic Administrators Association.

Sunday, April 15, 2018--1:30-5:30 pm LTC 714: *Athletic Administration: Dealing With Challenging Personalities:* Administrators seeking to understand the role of human personality in defining a challenging personality or behavior, and seeking strategies for dealing with aggressive, rigid, sarcastic, or condescending personalities.

Monday, April 16, 2018—8:00 a.m. - Noon LTC 700: *Athletic Administration:* Specifically for Middle School Athletic Administrators, this course provides insights and strategies for the leadership of developmentally sound educationally compatible middle level school athletic programs. Middle school philosophy is discussed along with the relationship it has to the psychological and physical development of the middle school child.

Monday, April 16, 2018--1:30-5:30 pm LTC 504: *Athletic Administration: Legal Issues I (Risk Management)* Enrollees who will derive the greatest benefit: Administrators seeking information concerning Constitutional Law and the need of exposure to causes for negligence and to legal “standards of care.”
