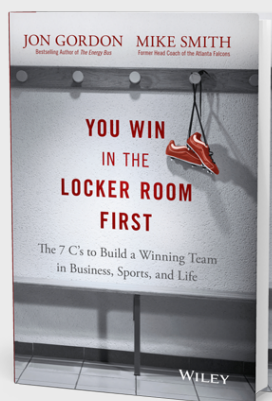
New membership for both the TIAAA and NIAAA will be available August 1, 2016 for the '16-'17 school year.
